## CAPE CORAL'S FIRST BIKE NIGHT

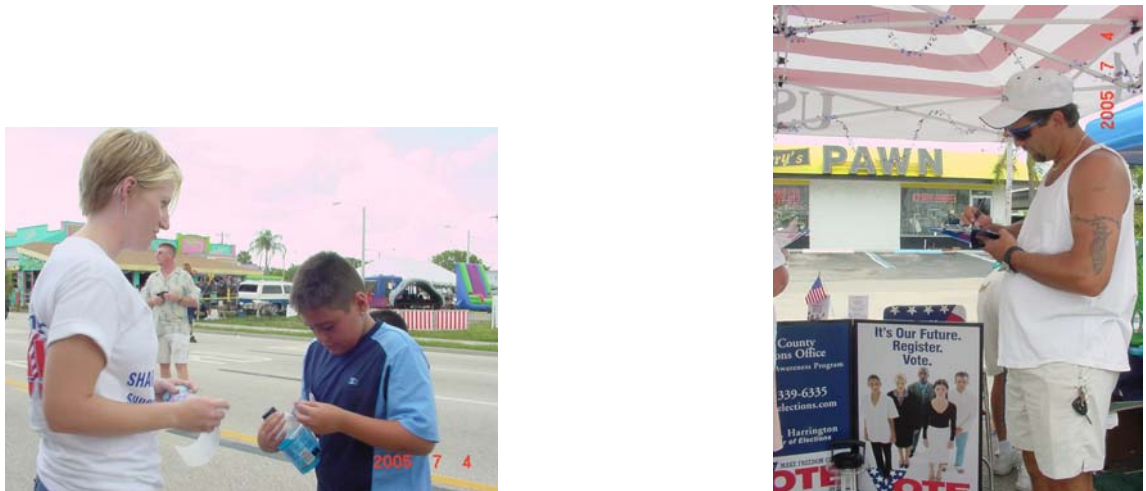
