IMPORTANT ELECTION DAY INFORMATION

Lee County, FL (November 7, 2022) As a result of Hurricane Ian's impact on Lee County's election operations, only 13 voting locations will be open on Election Day, November 8, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Voters may vote at any of the voting sites on Election Day, regardless of their assigned precinct.

Voters may only drop off their Vote-by-Mail Ballot at a Lee County Supervisor of Elections Office before 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.
