Lee County Supervisor of Elections Announces Canvassing Board Meetings and Logic and Accuracy Testing Schedule for the August 23 Primary Election

Lee County, FL (July 22, 2022) On Monday, July 25, 2022, Lee County Supervisor of Elections, the Honorable Tommy Doyle, will conduct the Logic and Accuracy Testing (L&A) of the voting machines to be used at Early Voting sites, precincts on Election Day, and Vote-by-Mail tabulation equipment for the August 23 Primary Election, pursuant to 101.5612 FS. The L&A test is conducted before every election to ensure that ballots are printed correctly and that the voting system is counting votes correctly.

The L&A will begin at 9:00 a.m., Monday, July 25, 2022, at the Lee County Elections Center, 13180 S Cleveland Ave., Fort Myers. Immediately after, the L&A will progress to the Lee County Elections Main Office, located at the Melvin Morgan Constitutional Complex, 2480 Thompson St, 3rd floor, Fort Myers, to test the Vote-by-Mail tabulation equipment and to canvass the Vote-by-Mail Ballots received to date for the Primary Election.

In Florida, an elections County Canvassing Board (a county judge, county commissioner, and the supervisor of elections) is responsible for overseeing all public pretesting of a sample of the tabulation equipment used in an election (also known as Logic and Accuracy Testing), examining ballots or groups of ballots, determining voter intent when required by law, compiling election returns, conducting recounts when required by law, determining the official results of an election, certifying an election, and conducting post-election manual audits in order to check voting system performance.
