The annual High School Voter Registration Challenge aims to provide voter education and increase voter registration among Lee County's youth. "Voter education is paramount in ensuring our youth become active participants in the electoral process", states Tommy Doyle, Lee County Supervisor of Elections. "We're thankful for our partnerships with the schools and their support in voter education."

Eleven out of the 15 high schools invited by Lee Elections participated in the challenge. Team members from the Lee Elections Community Education Services Department registered and pre-registered **1,256 new voters** ages 16 and older across all the participating schools.

This year's challenge began on September 12, 2022, and was originally scheduled to end on February 3, 2023; however, the deadline was extended to February 24 due to the impact of Hurricane Ian in Lee County.
